CONFERENCE GOAL

Exploitation of already shrinking natural resources results in social inequalities, also in terms of providing high quality of life, as well as generates new challenges for economic development. These complex problems raise a question related to sustainability of development of modern world, environmental justice and social justice. Importance of such issues was underlined by the Noble Prize winner in Economics in 2018, William D. Nordhaus, who stated that 'nature dictates conditions, which we live in, however it is knowledge, that describes our ability to manage these conditions'.

In order to meet these challenges the organisers propose topics of the conference related to social and environmental justice and their economic aspects. Main themes will be:

- Equity in concepts of economics discipline;
- Social and environmental justice new generation of challenges for politics of regional and local development;
- Equity in access to social and environmental services;
- City as a common good;
- Urban resilience and a just city concept;
- Social justice in urban renewal projects;
- Equity in access to green-blue infrastructure in cities.

Important part of the conference will include workshop on environmental injustice and field session related to social justice in urban renewal projects.
